## Applying to U of G

10th standard board results and predicted Class 12 grades, anticipated IBs, final (I)GCSE, AS and predicted A Levels can be emailed to [intdocs@uoguelph.ca](mailto:intdocs@uoguelph.ca).

## Indian Curriculum

Verified 10th standard board results accompanied by anticipated Class 12 grades listed by subject from the school, with a minimum average of 80%. Completion of Class 12 Board Exam Certificate with strong First Division standing is required in May/June. All information required by the board to verify your Class 10 and 12 certificates. Students wishing to pursue a Bachelor of Science or Bachelor of Commerce who do not have 12th Standard Math please register and complete an [ilc.org](http://ilc.org) MHF4U Math for Biological Science or Commerce and MCV4U Math for Physical Science degrees with a minimum 75-80% depending on degree/major. For other options please email [india@uoguelph.ca](mailto:india@uoguelph.ca). Final Indian curriculum graduating documents must be submitted to Admission Services from the corresponding board. When possible, Admission Services will verify scanned finals online.

## International Baccalaureate

A marksheet with anticipated IB scores reflecting the intention to complete the full IB Diploma with 6 subjects: 3 HL and 3 SL (including prerequisites) with a minimum score of 28 including bonus points from TOK and EE, however most programs will require a higher score. Students should ensure that their anticipated scores are submitted using the 7-point scale.

**TRANSFER CREDIT FOR IBs** may be given for HL courses with scores of 5 or above to a maximum of 2.0 credits and will be assigned once official transcripts are received from the IBO. Please email transcripts.[ibna@ibo.org](mailto:ibna@ibo.org) to request for your official results to be sent directly to U of G.

**Note:** Math Studies/SL Applications and Interpretations are not acceptable Math prerequisites for most programs on the main campus.

## British Curriculum

**GCE:** Minimum of 2 A Level passes and 3 (I)GCSE (O Level) passes in 5 unique subjects. 2 AS Level courses may be substituted for 1 A Level course. Students are expected to present a minimum of A/B or 6/7 to begin consideration on (I)GCSE, AS and predicted A Level examinations. Students are strongly encouraged to present prerequisite courses at the AS or A Level. Official GCE results need to be sent directly by Pearson/Edexcel/Cambridge.

**Note:** General Paper is not considered an acceptable subject.

**TRANSFER CREDIT FOR GCEs** will be considered for A Level subjects with a final grade of C or above, up to a maximum of 3.0 credits.

## English Proficiency

English proficiency is required if your primary or first language is not English and you have had less than 4 years of full-time

secondary school or post-secondary school study, demonstrating satisfactory academic progress, in an English-language school system [admission.uoguelph.ca/englprof](http://admission.uoguelph.ca/englprof).
